

SODHA DATASET VERSION MANAGEMENT POLICY

When a dataset is deposited in the SODHA repository, it first exists in a 'Draft' and 'Unpublished' version.

After the depositor submits it for review and a SODHA administrator publishes it, it then becomes 'Version 1.0'.

From here, whenever the depositor of the dataset modifies the dataset, there are two possibilities:

- 1) **Major release:** The modifications are considered consequential, so the primary version number is incremented $(1.x \rightarrow 2.x)$;
- 2) **Minor release:** The modifications are considered small-scale, so only the secondary version number is incremented $(x.1 \rightarrow x.2)$.

The following modifications are characteristic of a major release:

- 1. Any of the following fields (and their subfields) in the **Metadata** section was modified: 'Title of Dataset', 'Other ID', 'Author', 'Contact', 'Description'.
- 2. A field was modified in the Terms section.
- 3. A file was added or removed.
- 4. Access to a file was changed (restricted or opened).

Whenever modifications to a dataset include one of these, the version change is considered a major release.

In any other case, the version change is considered a minor release.
